Panel One:

Panel Two:

ANGLE ON SCENE. Shot of five cards on the table that consist of a Q, J, and 10 of spades and a J of diamonds and a K of hearts.

Panel Three:

ANGLE ON SCENE. Shot of Edie sitting there with a great poker face and his two cards face down. We can see people and other casino things in the background.

Panel One:
EXT. NIGHT. Edie walking down the sidewalk in the city with his hands in his pockets with his head down.

Panel Two:

Edie is walking by a small news stand and there is a guy holding up a newspaper. The guy is older with long hair, a beard, and glasses. He is wearing a long sleeve shirt, a sweater vest and a hat. There is a guy standing next to the stand, but we don't see his face because he is holding up an open newspaper reading. We see his legs and hands only. He wears black pants and has a big green ring on his right hand. Edie just looks at he news guy.

It will help, being informed always helps you get through.

Panel Three:

ANOTHER ANGLE. The news guy is giving Edie the newspaper smiling and Edie is taking it and giving him the change for it.

EDIE

NEWS GUY

My pleasure. Hope it works like it should.

Panel Four:

We see the full front page of the news paper and Edie's hands holding it. The headline reads "Casino City is turning to GREEN!" Of course you did. That's what being a professional gambler is all about right? Winning and losing lots and lots of money.

Panel Six:

ANOTHER ANGLE. Edie has turned to her and she has her back turned and is taking her towel off her hair.

VEGA

God forbid you win big and we have enough to get the hell out of here and start a real life. Why won't you just come with me? My parents said they would pay for everything until you can find a real good stable job.

Panel Seven:

We are in front of Vega and Edie holds her from behind with his head resting on her shoulder.

EDIE

I know I'm sorry I'm being difficult, but I don't want to do that to your parents.

VEGA

We have to leave this city soon. I'm afraid if we don't something horrible will happen.

EDIE

We'll be fine. I'll be fine. I'm going to win plenty of money and then come and meet you and start a new life. You just have to trust me.

Panel Eight:

Vega has turned and they hold each other close and look at each other in the eyes and smiling.

Panel One:

INT. BEDROOM. Vega lays in the bed sleeping and Edie sits on the edge of the bed wearing only his pants. The newspaper lies on the floor in front of him. Edie has his hands on his head.

Panel Two:

Edie notices the newspaper and picks it up.

Panel Three:

We see a close side shot of Edie looking at the paper.

Panel Two:
Edie's face is covered with a black bag and the two men have grabbed him. We don't see the men's faces because of the darkness.
EDIE
What the fuck!
GUYS Your coming with us!
Panel Three:
INT. OFFICE. Edie is sitting in a chair and the two guys stand on either side of him with the black bag in one of their hand. The room looks very rich with nice shiny wood and expensive furniture. There is a big window to look upon the city. Mr. Green is leaning on the front of his huge desk with his arms crossed. His right hand should always be covered as much as possible.

Ha Ha. No one talks to The Boss. No one even sees The Boss. I've never even seen

GREEN Edie Walker, good to see you. I've been wondering when I would get to meet you.
EDIE What?
Panel Four:
Mr. Green is closer to Edie and holds open a cigar box and smiles. Edie looks confused.
GREEN

Panel Five:
Edie holds the cigar and Mr. Green holds a slicer to cut the end off.

Panel Six:

Panel Seven:
Edie sits with the lit cigar and Mr. Green has moved to the window.

GREEN

I'm a nice guy, I can work with you. I don't understand why you would want to leave a city like this one. If you were to stay, we would see that it be worth your while.

What do you mean?

PAGE FIVE

Panel One:

Mr. Green has turned to Edie and Edie stands beside him.

GREEN

Mr. DeVos has become somewhat of a problem for us. He has exceeded his boundaries in his power. We've been watching you and studied your history. You would be a perfect candidate for his position. Good business man, gambler, no fear, and will take out anyone in your way.

EDIE

I'm not that man anymore. I'm just a gambler.

GREEN

Sure, sure, but if you took the position, then your slate would be clean.

Panel Two:

Mr. Green has a hand on Edie's shoulder.

EDIE

Thanks for the offer, but I can't do it. I love Vega too much. I have to be with her.

I understand. Well, then I guess we will have to settle with paying \$1 million and doing a few jobs for us along the way.

Panel Four:
Shot of the dealer at the table with Edie. The dealer is laying down a King of hearts.
Panel Five:
The dealer is laying down a Queen of diamonds.
Panel Six:
Darkness again with just lit hands and cards. The K, Q, J are still laid down along with a 2 of spades and the hand is laying down a 4 of hearts.
Panel Seven:
At the table with Edie and the dealer. The cards are the same along with 2 of spades and the dealer is laying 4 of hearts.

Shot behind Edie at the slot machine with the two jackpots and a cherry.		
Panel Six:		
Close shot on Edie's face in complete shock.

Are you fucking shitting me?! Panel Seven:		

A side shot of Edie at the slot machine and a waitress stands next to him with a tray of
drinks and is handing him a drink. Edie just has his forehead on the slot machine and
hands on the side of it.

WAITRESS
Someone ordered you a cherry vodca sour.
EDIE What!
Panel Eight:
We see a front shot of Edie sitting at the slot machine holding the drink and looking around with a confused look.
EDIE
What the fuck?!

PAGE EIGHT

Splash Page:

It is mostly dark on the page. We do see Edie sitting down staring into the glass. We can also see the two hands lit above Edie. The style is like a puppet with a puppet master. With Edie being the puppet and staring into the glass and the hands being the master controlling him. The lighting is as if there was a spotlight above the hands and over Edie sitting.
